EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED IN § 10-641 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THIS PART V OF THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT AUTHORIZE:

- (1) THE DESTRUCTION OF A PERMANENT BOOK OF ACCOUNT;
- (2) THE DESTRUCTION OF A LAND RECORD OF A CLERK OF A CIRCUIT COURT;
- (3) THE DESTRUCTION OF ANY RECORD THAT RELATES TO THE FINANCIAL OPERATION OF A UNIT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT OR TO COLLECTION OF STATE TAXES UNTIL THE REQUIREMENTS OF §§ 2-1215 THROUGH 2-1222 OF THIS ARTICLE ARE MET;
- (4) THE DESTRUCTION OF ANY RECORD UNTIL THE EXPIRATION OF THE PERIOD THAT A STATUTE EXPRESSLY SETS FOR THAT RECORD TO BE KEPT;
