11-204. CHAIRMAN.

FROM AMONG THE APPOINTED MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN.

11-205. MEETINGS; COMPENSATION.

(A) MEETINGS.

THE COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT LEAST QUARTERLY, ON THE CALL OF ITS CHAIRMAN OR THE COORDINATOR.

(B) REIMBURSEMENT.

EACH APPOINTED MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

In subsection (b) of this section, the reference to the "Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget" is substituted for the former reference to "reasonable expenses incurred as a member", for clarity. Standard State Travel Regulations are adopted by the Department of Personnel with the approval of the Board of Public Works.
