11-402. STATE MASTER APPLICATION FORM.

(A) DEVELOPMENT.

IF FEASIBLE AND WITH THE COOPERATION OF EACH STATE UNIT THAT HAS AUTHORITY TO ISSUE A DEVELOPMENT PERMIT, THE COORDINATOR SHALL DEVELOP A STATE MASTER APPLICATION FORM AND APPROPRIATE APPENDICES FOR USE IN APPLYING FOR MULTIPLE DEVELOPMENT PERMITS.

(B) USE.

THE STATE MASTER APPLICATION FORM AND ITS APPENDICES MAY BE USED INSTEAD OF INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION FORMS.

11-403. SPECIFICATIONS FOR FORM.

THE STATE MASTER APPLICATION FORM SHALL PROVIDE:

(1) THE BASIC INFORMATION ABOUT A DEVELOPMENT PROJECT THAT IS COMMON TO AND NEEDED BY ALL OR MOST OF THE STATE UNITS THAT ISSUE DEVELOPMENT PERMITS; AND

(2) SPACE IN WHICH TO:

(I) LIST EACH STATE UNIT FROM WHICH A DEVELOPMENT PERMIT IS REQUESTED; AND

(II) DESCRIBE EACH DEVELOPMENT PERMIT.
