- (2) THE COMPLETION OF THE CONTRACT THAT GIVES RISE TO THE CLAIM.

TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE BUDGET BILL MONEY THAT IS ADEQUATE TO SATISFY A FINAL JUDGMENT THAT, AFTER THE EXHAUSTION OF THE RIGHTS OF APPEAL, IS RENDERED AGAINST THE STATE OR ANY OF ITS OFFICERS OR UNITS.

SUBTITLE 3. ACTIONS AGAINST STATE OFFICERS AND STATE EMPLOYEES.

PART I. GENERAL PROVISION.

12-301. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO:

- (1) THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION;
- (2) A BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS OF A COUNTY;
- (3) THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OR A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION; OR
 - (4) ANY OTHER COUNTY OFFICER OR UNIT.
