

A CUSTODIAN SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF A HOSPITAL RECORD THAT:

(1) RELATES TO:

- (I) MEDICAL ADMINISTRATION;
- (II) STAFF;
- (III) MEDICAL CARE; OR
- (IV) OTHER MEDICAL INFORMATION; AND

(2) CONTAINS GENERAL OR SPECIFIC INFORMATION ABOUT 1 OR MORE INDIVIDUALS.

(J) STUDENT RECORDS.

(1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A CUSTODIAN SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT RECORD ABOUT THE BIOGRAPHY, FAMILY, PHYSIOLOGY, RELIGION, ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT, OR PHYSICAL OR MENTAL ABILITY OF A STUDENT.

(2) A CUSTODIAN SHALL PERMIT INSPECTION BY:

- (I) THE PERSON IN INTEREST; OR
- (II) AN ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICIAL WHO SUPERVISES THE STUDENT.

5-108. REQUIRED DENIALS -- SPECIFIC INFORMATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, A CUSTODIAN SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF A PART OF A PUBLIC RECORD, AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) MEDICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL INFORMATION.
