Article 78 - Public Service Commission Law

(i) Subject to § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT Article [40, § 51 of the Code], the utility consumer advisory panel shall report on its activities to the General Assembly by January 1 of each year.

The Commission shall make an annual report, summarizing the activities of the Commission, to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT Article [40, § 51 of the Code], to the General Assembly on or before the third Wednesday of March of each year. The Commission also shall publish annually a report which shall include the summary of Commission activities, including the progress of the residential conservation service plan and Commission activities directed toward the moderation of peak electrical demand and energy conservation measures to reduce electrical and natural gas demand by public gas and electric utilities in this State, as well as all rules, regulations, opinions, and orders promulgated or entered by the Commission during the calendar year covered by the annual report, and any other information which the Commission deems of value.
