(f) The Board shall meet regularly, and shall submit an annual report, subject to § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT Article [40, § 51 of the Code], to the local legislative delegation of the General Assembly concerning the status of the Scenic and Wild River Program. The Board shall recommend for inclusion in the scenic and wild rivers system, rivers, streams, portions of rivers, streams, and tributaries based on the inventory and studies of the Department and the recommendations of the appropriate local advisory boards.

(d) [Subject to Article 40, § 51 of the Code, the] THE Department shall report every two years to the Governor and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE General Assembly on January 1 concerning the progress of the implementation of this subtitle.
