Any program adopted under this subtitle terminates on January 1, 1983 unless, prior to its termination, its period of operation is extended by an act of the General Assembly or the Governor.

## Article - Health - General

10-911.

In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in Part II of this subtitle, [the Secretary shall:

- (1) On or before January 1, 1983, subject to Article 40, § 51 of the Code, submit to the General Assembly a report that evaluates the program.
- (2) In] IN consultation with the advisory committee, THE SECRETARY SHALL:
- [(i)] (1) Set the policies for operation and management of the program;
- [(ii)] (2) Adopt rules and regulations for admission of individuals to the program; and
- [(iii)] (3) Make contractual arrangements for operation of the program.
