

(1) Discussion or consideration of employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, salaries, disciplining or resignation of public officers, appointees or employees of any public body[.];

(2) Discussion or consideration of the condition, acquisition or use of real property for public purpose, or of the disposition of publicly held property[.];

(3) The protection of the privacy of individuals in personal matters not related to public business[.];

(4) Discussion concerning a prospective business or industry where no previous announcement has been made of the business' or industry's interest in locating in the community[.];

(5) The investing of public funds where competition or bargaining are involved, where if made public initially the financial interest of the government unit would be adversely affected[.];

(6) Consultation with legal counsel and briefings by staff members, consultants or attorneys, pertaining to pending litigation, or legal matters within the jurisdiction of the public body, including legal documents[.]; AND

(7) Discussion of any matter which will be the topic of public hearing prior to a final decision, provided that notice of the public hearing shall be published generally in the community not less than ten days prior to the public hearing.

(b) "Advisory function" means the study of a matter of public concern or the making of recommendations on the matter, under a delegation of responsibility by:

(1) law;

(2) the Governor; [or]

(3) THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE; OR

(4) formal action by or for a public body.

(c) (1) "Executive function" means the administration of:

(I) a law of the State;

(II) A LAW OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE; or
