- (c) A public body may give the notice under this section as follows:
- (1) IF THE PUBLIC BODY IS A UNIT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT, by publication in the Maryland Register;
- (2) by delivery to representatives of the news media who regularly report on sessions of the public body or the activities of the [State] government OF WHICH THE PUBLIC BODY IS A PART;
- (3) if the public body previously has given public notice that this method will be used, by posting or depositing the notice at a convenient public location at or near the place of the session; or
 - (4) by any other reasonable method.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "POLITICAL SUBDIVISION" MEANS:

- (1) A COUNTY;
- (2) A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THE STATE;
- (3) AN UNINCORPORATED TOWN IN THE STATE;
- (4) A SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE STATE; OR
- (5) ANY SPECIAL DISTRICT IN THE STATE.
