

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 52 and the subtitle "Artistic Property" of Article 78A - Public Works, of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

ARTICLE 54 - STATE ARCHIVES AND ARTISTIC PROPERTY

PART I. STATE ARCHIVES AND HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION.

1-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS PART I OF THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) ARCHIVES.

"ARCHIVES" MEANS THE STATE ARCHIVES.

(C) COMMISSION.

"COMMISSION" MEANS THE HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION.

1-102. ARCHIVES AND COMMISSION ESTABLISHED.

(A) ARCHIVES.

THERE IS A STATE ARCHIVES IN THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR.

(B) COMMISSION.

THERE IS A HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION.

1-103. MEMBERSHIP OF COMMISSION.

THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 10 MEMBERS:

- (1) THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS;
- (2) A SENATOR APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- (3) A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;
- (4) THE COMPTROLLER;
- (5) THE TREASURER;
