

1-117. COMMISSION ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A COMMISSION ON ARTISTIC PROPERTY IN THE STATE ARCHIVES.

1-118. MEMBERSHIP.

(A) COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.

(1) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF 5 MEMBERS.

(2) OF THE 5 MEMBERS, AT LEAST 1 SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF A CULTURAL INSTITUTION LOCATED IN THE STATE.

(3) THE STATE ARCHIVIST SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR.

(B) TENURE.

THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE STATE ARCHIVIST.

(C) CHAIRMAN.

FROM TIME TO TIME, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR, THE STATE ARCHIVIST SHALL DESIGNATE A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION TO SERVE AS CHAIRMAN.

1-119. COMPENSATION; STAFF.

(A) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(B) STAFF.

THE COMMISSION MAY EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

1-120. GIFTS AND LOANS.

(A) DECORATIVE ARTS.

(1) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR AND THE STATE ARCHIVIST, THE COMMISSION MAY ACCEPT, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE:

(I) A GIFT OF ANY PAINTING OR OTHER OBJECT OF DECORATIVE ART; AND
