- (II) A LOAN OF ANY PAINTING OR OTHER OBJECT OF DECORATIVE ART.
- (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL CARE FOR ANY OBJECT OF DECORATIVE ART ACCEPTED UNDER THIS SECTION.
 - (B) MONETARY GIFTS.

WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR, THE STATE ARCHIVIST:

- (1) MAY ACCEPT A GIFT OF MONEY FROM ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SOURCE; AND
- (2) SHALL ADMINISTER AND USE THE GIFT OF MONEY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANY CONDITIONS OF THE GIFT.
- 1-121. DUTIES OF COMMISSION.
 - (A) IN GENERAL.

AS TO ALL VALUABLE PAINTINGS OR OTHER OBJECTS OF DECORATIVE ART LOCATED IN OR-ON-THE-PREMISES A PUBLIC AREA OF ANY STATE BUILDING IN THE ANNAPOLIS AREA, EXCEPT IN A STATE ROOM OF GOVERNMENT HOUSE, THE COMMISSION SHALL:

- (1) KEEP A CONTINUING INVENTORY OF THE OBJECTS; AND
- (2) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR AND SUPERVISE THE ACQUISITION, CUSTODY, DISPLAY, LOCATION, PRESERVATION, PROPER CARE, SECURITY, AND RESTORATION OF THE OBJECTS.
 - (B) ACQUISITION.
- (1) EACH PERSON OR AGENCY THAT DESIRES TO ACQUIRE A PAINTING OR OBJECT OF DECORATIVE ART FOR DISPLAY IN OR ON THE PREMISES OF ANY STATE BUILDING IN THE ANNAPOLIS AREA, EXCEPT IN A ROOM OF GOVERNMENT HOUSE, MUST RECEIVE BOTH PRIOR APPROVAL AND FINAL ACCEPTANCE FROM THE COMMISSION.
- (2) BEFORE GIVING PRIOR APPROVAL OR FINAL ACCEPTANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL CONSIDER:
 - (I) THE COMPETENCE OF THE ARTIST;
 - (II) THE PROPOSED LOCATION OF THE OBJECT; AND
- (III) THE QUALITY, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE, AND APPROPRIATENESS OF THE WORK.
- 1-122. STATE ROOMS OF GOVERNMENT HOUSE.

AS TO ALL PAINTINGS OR OTHER OBJECTS OF DECORATIVE ART IN THE STATE ROOMS OF GOVERNMENT HOUSE, THE COMMISSION SHALL:
