~~(F)~~ (G) THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL CAUSE ANNUAL AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS OF THE MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION TO BE PREPARED AND FILED WITH THE GOVERNOR, THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR JOINT BUDGET AND AUDIT COMMITTEE, AND THE BOARD OF REGENTS AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF ITS FISCAL YEAR.

(3) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY TAKE THE ANNUAL REPORT INTO CONSIDERATION WHEN CONSIDERING REQUESTS BY THE MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE STATE, INCLUDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATING RESERVE FUND UNDER § 13-1B-09 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

~~(G)~~ (I) REQUESTS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR GRANTS FROM THE STATE FOR THE MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION MAY BE SUBMITTED ONLY WITH APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS.

~~(H)~~ (J) THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS WILL COORDINATE WITH UNIVERSITY FUND-RAISING EFFORTS ALL MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION CAMPAIGNS AND SOLICITATIONS FOR PRIVATE GIFTS AND PROPOSALS FOR PRIVATE OR FEDERAL GRANTS.
