5. Charitable Solicitations

5-1. Regulation.

(a) Authorized. The County Commissioners [of Washington County are hereby authorized to] MAY adopt rules and regulations to provide for the licensing and regulation of persons or groups conducting solicitations for charity in Washington County.

(b) Penalties. Any person [violating] WHO VIOLATES the rules and regulations established by the County Commissioners [shall be deemed] IS guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction [thereof] shall be fined not less than [five dollars (\$5.00)] \$5 nor more than [two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)] \$250.

7-1. Definitions.

(A) [For the purposes of] IN this subtitle[,] THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) (1) ["closing-out] "CLOSING-OUT sale" [shall mean and include] MEANS any sale in connection with which there is any representation by the person conducting [such] THE sale that the sale is being conducted, or is required or compelled to be conducted, for reasons of economic or business distress, inability to continue business at the same location, or the age or health of the owner or owners of the business.

(2) [, and the term "closing-out] "CLOSING-OUT sale" [shall include but not be limited to,] INCLUDES all sales
