

All fees collected under the provisions of this subtitle shall be collected by and used by the Board of Examiners and Supervisors to defray the necessary expenses of [said] THE Board. [and the] THE remainder [thereof] OF THE FUNDS shall be delivered to the [Board of] County Commissioners [of Washington County] on [the first day of] June 1 in each year. (1957 Code, sec. 221. 1951, ch. 328, sec. 179N.)

12-15. Board's report to County Commissioners.

[It shall be the duty of the said] THE Board, before the first Monday of May of each year, [to] SHALL make a report in writing to the [Board of] County Commissioners [of Washington County, containing] THAT CONTAINS a detailed statement of the nature of the receipts and manner of expenditure. (1957 Code, sec. 222. 1951, ch. 328, sec. 179-O.)

12-16. Occupations not covered by subtitle.

[The provisions of this] THIS subtitle [shall] DOES not apply to any electrical light company, electric railway company, steam railway company, telegraph or telephone company, nor to those persons, whether employees or not, performing electrical work for [such] THOSE companies. (1957 Code, sec. 223. 1951, ch. 328, sec. 179P.)

12-17. Meter cut-in certificates required.

(A) [After June 1, 1951, no] AN electric light or power company [shall] MAY NOT attach its power lines or electric meters to any consumer's property within the borders of Washington County unless and until a temporary or permanent meter cut-in certificate has been issued by the Middle-Department--Association of--Fire--Underwriters AGENCY AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE THE CERTIFICATE BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
