

(b) Conditions and restrictions. Arrangements with commercial banks and savings and loan associations to collect taxes [pursuant to] UNDER this section shall be subject to any additional conditions and restrictions which the County Treasurer considers appropriate, including accounting, issuance of receipts, remittance, and commissions.

(c) Payment of taxes. Upon the payment of any State or County real estate or personal property taxes to a commercial bank or a savings and loan association authorized under this section to accept taxes, the taxes owing to the State or County are paid. (1977, ch. 836.)

36-20. Same; legislative intent.

The intention of sections 36-4 - 36-20 is to facilitate and expedite the collection of taxes in Washington County, and thereby generally promote the business of the County Commissioners' office [in said County and for]. FOR that purpose all the provisions of Sections 36-4 - 36-20 shall be liberally construed. (1957 Code, sec. 718. 1945, ch. 368, sec. 805R.)

#### 37. Trespass

37-1. Trespass unlawful; penalty.

37-2. Discharging firearm near dwelling.

37-1. Trespass unlawful; penalty.

(A) [It shall be unlawful for any person in Washington County to go upon lands of another] A PERSON MAY NOT GO ON ANOTHER PERSON'S LAND to hunt or fish [thereon] against the will and WITHOUT THE consent of the owner or occupant [thereof]. [It is unlawful for any person to enter upon the lands of another]

(B) A PERSON MAY NOT GO ON ANOTHER PERSON'S LAND and injure or carry away any grain or fruit, or tear down or injure any
