40-1. Payment for witnesses.

40-2. Orders for payment.

Whenever any person [shall present] PRESENTS to the collector of [said] THE county[,] an order from the clerk of the circuit court for [his] THE PERSON'S attendance as a witness, [he] THE CLERK shall pay to [such] THE person, or [his] TO THE PERSON'S order, the amount due [him] THE PERSON, after deducting [therefrom] all charges [he] THE CLERK may have against [such] THE witness. 41. Washington County Museum of Fine Arts

41-1.

- (a) In this [chapter] SUBTITLE, the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Board" means the Board of Trustees of the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts.
- (c) "Museum" means the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts.

41-2.

- (a) There is a Board of Trustees of the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts.
 - (b) The Board consists of 18 trustees as follows:
 - 15 trustees appointed by the Board;
- (2) As an ex officio member, the president of the Board of County Commissioners [of Washington County] or a county commissioner designated by the president;
- (3) As an ex officio member, the superintendent of schools of Washington County; and
- (4) As an ex officio member, the Mayor of the City of Hagerstown or a city council member designated by the Mayor.
 - (c) (1) Each trustee serves for a term of 5 years.
