Preamble

In adopting this Act, it is the purpose of the General Assembly to carry out the proposals on pension benefits that were approved by the Joint Legislative and Executive Committee on Pensions and that are described in the Committee's report to the 1984 General Assembly; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
