- (3) INFORMATION AND REFERRAL SERVICES FAMILIES HOW TO LOCATE AND USE COMMUNITY SERVICES, INCLUDING HEALTH CARE SERVICES; AND
- (4) HOME MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO TEACH THE MANAGEMENT OF HOUSEHOLD DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES, INCLUDING BUDGETING SKILLS.

- 4-403. DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
 - (A) IN GENERAL.

THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL CONTINUE TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN A PROGRAM TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE IN EACH LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES.

- (B) SPECIFIC DUTIES.
- IN IMPLEMENTING THE PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL:
- (1) ADOPT RULES, REGULATIONS, AND GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTING THE PROGRAM IN EACH LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES:
- (2) CONTINUOUSLY MONITOR AND EVALUATE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE PROGRAM; AND
- (3) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, COORDINATE FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN THE DELIVERY OF DAY CARE, HEALTH, EDUCATIONAL, MENTAL HEALTH, EMPLOYMENT, HOUSING, AND CRISIS SERVICES PROVIDED BY PUBLIC AND PRIVATE AGENCIES.
