State projects and \$21,000,000 represents that share of Program Open Space revenues available for local programs; these amounts may be used for any State projects or local shares authorized in Chapter 403, Laws of Maryland, 1969 as amended; and for any of the following State projects, unless the General Assembly has authorized an alternative list of State projects totalling no more than \$21,000,000, in which case these amounts may be spent for such alternative State projects.
