(C) DISABILITY.

"DISABILITY" MEANS:

(1) A MENTAL DISORDER, AS DEFINED IN § 10-101 OF THE HEALTH - GENERAL ARTICLE;

(2) MENTAL RETARDATION, AS DEFINED IN § 7-101 OF THE HEALTH - GENERAL ARTICLE;

(3) CHRONIC ALCOHOLISM, AS DEFINED IN § 8-101 OF THE HEALTH - GENERAL ARTICLE; OR

(4) DRUG ADDICTION, AS DEFINED IN § 9-101 OF THE HEALTH - GENERAL ARTICLE.

(D) FATHER.

"FATHER" MEANS THE MAN WHO IS THE NATURAL FATHER OF A CHILD UNDER § 5-310 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(E) GUARDIANSHIP.

"GUARDIANSHIP" MEANS GUARDIANSHIP WITH THE RIGHT TO CONSENT TO ADOPTION OR LONG-TERM CARE SHORT OF ADOPTION.

(F) INDEPENDENT ADOPTION.

"INDEPENDENT ADOPTION" MEANS AN ADOPTION IN WHICH THE ARRANGEMENT FOR ADOPTION IS NOT MADE BY A CHILD PLACEMENT AGENCY.
