- (B) IDENTITY OF PERSON INVOLVED IN NEGLECT NOT TO BE DISCLOSED.

- (1) THE NAME OF ANY PERSON WHO IS INVOLVED IN A CHILD NEGLECT CASE; OR
- (2) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT DISCLOSES THE IDENTITY OF AN INDIVIDUAL INVOLVED IN A CHILD NEGLECT CASE.

SUBTITLE 8. UNATTENDED CHILDREN.

5-801. CONFINEMENT IN DWELLING, BUILDING, OR ENCLOSURE -- ANNE ARUNDEL, CHARLES, CALVERT, AND ST. MARY'S COUNTIES.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL, CALVERT, CHARLES, AND ST. MARY'S COUNTIES.

(B) IN GENERAL.

A PERSON WHO IS CHARGED WITH THE CARE OF A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 8 YEARS MAY NOT ALLOW THE CHILD TO BE LOCKED OR CONFINED IN A DWELLING, BUILDING, OR ENCLOSURE WHILE THE PERSON CHARGED IS ABSENT UNLESS THE PERSON CHARGED PROVIDES A RELIABLE PERSON AT LEAST 13 YEARS OLD TO REMAIN WITH THE CHILD TO PROTECT THE CHILD FROM FIRE, SCALDING, SMOKE INHALATION, OR SUFFOCATION.

(C) VIOLATION.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR, OR BOTH.
