- (1) WHERE THE ALLEGEDLY ABUSED CHILD LIVES; OR
- (2) $\underline{\text{IF DIFFERENT}}$ WHERE THE ABUSE IS ALLEGED TO HAVE TAKEN PLACE.

(H) LOCAL STATE'S ATTORNEY.

- (1) WHERE THE ALLEGEDLY ABUSED CHILD LIVES; OR
- (2) $\underline{\text{IF DIFFERENT}}$ WHERE THE ABUSE IS ALLEGED TO HAVE TAKEN PLACE.

(I) POLICE OFFICER.
