"COURT" MEANS:

- (1) AS TO CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS, THE DISTRICT COURT AND ANY OTHER COURT IN THIS STATE THAT EXERCISES CRIMINAL JURISDICTION OVER THE ENFORCEMENT OF LAWS RESPECTING DUTIES OF SUPPORT:
- (2) AS TO CIVIL PROCEEDINGS, THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANY COUNTY AND JUVENILE COURTS HAVING JURISDICTION OVER THE CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OF LAWS RESPECTING DUTIES OF SUPPORT; AND
- (3) AS TO PROCEEDINGS IN ANOTHER STATE, THE COURT OF ANY OTHER STATE AS DEFINED IN A SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR RECIPROCAL LAW.
