10-305. INTERSTATE RENDITION.

(A) POWERS OF GOVERNOR.

THE GOVERNOR OF THIS STATE MAY:

(1) DEMAND OF THE GOVERNOR OF ANY OTHER STATE THE SURRENDER OF ANY PERSON FOUND IN THAT STATE WHO IS CHARGED IN THIS STATE WITH THE CRIME OF FAILING TO PROVIDE FOR THE SUPPORT OF ANY PERSON IN THIS STATE; AND

(2) SURRENDER ON DEMAND BY THE GOVERNOR OF ANY OTHER STATE ANY PERSON FOUND IN THIS STATE WHO IS CHARGED IN THAT STATE WITH THE CRIME OF FAILING TO PROVIDE FOR THE SUPPORT OF A PERSON IN THE OTHER STATE.

(B) PROVISIONS AS TO LOCATION OF PERSON TO BE EXTRADITED.

PROVISIONS FOR EXTRADITION OF CRIMINALS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS SUBTITLE APPLY TO ANY DEMAND EVEN IF THE PERSON WHOSE SURRENDER IS DEMANDED WAS NOT IN THE DEMANDING STATE AT THE TIME OF THE COMMISSION OF THE CRIME AND HAS NOT FLED FROM THAT STATE. THE DEMAND, THE OATH, AND ANY PROCEEDINGS FOR EXTRADITION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION NEED NOT STATE OR SHOW THAT THE PERSON WHOSE SURRENDER IS DEMANDED HAS FLED FROM JUSTICE, OR AT THE TIME OF THE COMMISSION OF THE CRIME WAS IN THE DEMANDING OR THE OTHER STATE.
