THE FOREIGN SUPPORT ORDER IS REGISTERED ON THE FILING OF THE PETITION SUBJECT ONLY TO SUBSEQUENT ORDER OF CONFIRMATION.

10-337. PROCEDURE AFTER REGISTRATION.

THE PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN JURISDICTION OVER THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OF THE OBLIGOR IS AS PROVIDED IN CIVIL CASES. THE OBLIGOR MAY ASSERT ANY DEFENSE AVAILABLE TO A DEFENDANT IN AN ACTION ON A FOREIGN JUDGMENT. IF THE OBLIGOR DEFAULTS, THE COURT SHALL ENTER AN ORDER CONFIRMING THE REGISTERED SUPPORT ORDER AND DETERMINING THE AMOUNTS REMAINING UNPAID. IF THE OBLIGOR APPEARS AND A HEARING IS HELD, THE COURT SHALL DECIDE THE ISSUES INCLUDING THE AMOUNTS REMAINING UNPAID.
