- (a) When the General Assembly meets, the following officers of the preceding General Assembly shall be present:
 - (1) from the Senate:
- (i) the Secretary or, if the Secretary is unable to attend, the journal clerk; and
- (ii) the doorkeeper or, if the doorkeeper is unable to attend, the assistant doorkeeper; and
 - (2) from the House:
- (i) the Chief Clerk or, if the Chief Clerk is unable to attend, the journal clerk;
 - (ii) the reading clerk; and
