- (c) (1) The Office shall receive and analyze requests] AND FROM OTHER PERSONS for payment of legislative expenses, including:
 - (i) office rent;
 - (ii) secretarial and other services;
- (iii) telephone and other communication expenses;
 - (iv) equipment;
 - (v) supplies; and
 - (vi) travel.
