- (i) the request to prepare the bill and the directive to file that bill, from a member who is reelected or another member-elect; or
- (ii) the directive to file the bill, from a member who is reelected and had requested the preparation of that bill before the election; and

- (i) the request to prepare the bill, on or before November 15 of that year; and
- (ii) the directive to file that bill on or before November 25 of that year.]
- (1) IN A YEAR WHEN A-GENERAL AN ELECTION FOR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS HELD:
- (I) A BILL MAY BE PREFILED ONLY AFTER-THAT ELECTION BY AN INDIVIDUAL ELECTED OR RE-ELECTED TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT THAT ELECTION;
- (II) THE DEADLINE FOR DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT TO FILE A BILL FOR INTRODUCTION IS DECEMBER 1; AND

- (IV) AN INDIVIDUAL FIRST ELECTED AT THAT ELECTION WHO-WANTS-TO-PREFIBE-A-BIBL-SHALL MAY NOT REQUEST,-AFTER THE-ELECTION-BUT-ON-OR-BEFORE-NOVEMBER-20-OF-THAT-YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT TO PREPARE THE A BILL,-AND UNTIL AFTER THE ELECTION.
