- (a) This section does not apply to a public local law for:
 - (1) Dorchester County;
 - (2) Howard County;
 - (3) Montgomery County;
 - (4) Somerset County;
 - (5) Washington County;
 - (6) Wicomico County; or
 - (7) Worcester County.
- (b) Immediately after the General Assembly passes an emergency public local law:
- (1) the Secretary of the Senate, if the law is a Senate bill, or the Chief Clerk of the House, if the law is a House bill, shall mail a certified copy of the law:
