AN ACT concerning

Tidal Fish Licenses - Processing Fee for Court Clerk

- FOR-the-purpose-of-altering-the-amount-of-a-processing-fee-that-a court-clerk-shall-charge-an-applicant-for-certain-activities under-a-tidal-fish-license-
- FOR the purpose of repealing a tidal fish license surcharge collected by the court clerk as a processing fee; and providing that a court clerk shall retain as a processing fee a certain percentage of the annual license fee charged an applicant for certain activities under a tidal fish license; and providing for a delayed effective date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
