SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

~~(A) THE INDIVIDUAL WHO ENTERS INTO AN {Each} interstate compact {into which} OR OTHER AGREEMENT FOR this State {enters}, INCLUDING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, shall {be kept in} DELIVER THE ORIGINAL OR A COPY OF THE AGREEMENT TO the office of the Secretary of State.~~

~~(B) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL KEEP THE AGREEMENTS DELIVERED UNDER THIS SECTION.~~

Each interstate compact into which the State enters shall be kept in the office of the Secretary of State.]

7-104.

(A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE CARE, TREATMENT, OR SUPERVISION OF 1 INDIVIDUAL.

(B) THE INDIVIDUAL WHO, FOR THE STATE, ENTERS INTO AN INTERSTATE COMPACT OR ANY OTHER INTERSTATE AGREEMENT OF GENERAL APPLICATION, INCLUDING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, SHALL DELIVER THE ORIGINAL OR A COPY OF THE AGREEMENT TO THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

(C) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL KEEP AN AGREEMENT DELIVERED UNDER THIS SECTION:

(1) UNTIL ANY LIMIT THAT IS SET FOR THE AGREEMENT TO BECOME EFFECTIVE EXPIRES; AND

(2) IF THE AGREEMENT BECOMES EFFECTIVE, UNTIL IT IS ABROGATED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1984.
