(II) IF THE HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION TAKES ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST A SALARIED, LICENSED PHYSICIAN WITHOUT STAFF PRIVILEGES, INCLUDING TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT, SUSPENSION, OR PROBATION, FOR REASONS THAT MIGHT BE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER § 14-504 OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(III) IF THE HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION TAKES ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST A-MEDICAL-STUDENT-OR AN INDIVIDUAL IN A POSTGRADUATE MEDICAL TRAINING PROGRAM, INCLUDING REMOVAL FROM THE TRAINING PROGRAM, SUSPENSION, OR PROBATION FOR REASONS THAT MIGHT BE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER § 14-504 OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR

[(ii)] (IV) If a physician,-MED#GAL-STUDENT, OR AN INDIVIDUAL IN A POSTGRADUATE TRAINING PROGRAM voluntarily resigns from the staff, EMPLOY, OR TRAINING PROGRAM of the hospital or related institution while under a formal accusation under § 14-504 of this subtitle.
