- (C) A CONSTABLE WHO SHOWS PROPER IDENTIFICATION MAY RIDE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN BALTIMORE CITY DURING THE COURSE OF THE CONSTABLE'S EMPLOYMENT WITHOUT PAYING THE FARE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 373

(Senate Bill 874)

AN ACT concerning

Regional Planning Council and Tri-County Council of Southern Maryland - Status

FOR the purpose of providing that the Regional Planning Council and the Tri-County Council of Southern Maryland may not be placed in one of the principal departments of State government; and providing generally certain intergovernmental units may be exempted from placement in a principal department.
