AN ACT concerning

Board of Examiners of Psychologists - Licensing

FOR the purpose of altering certain exceptions to the license requirement for individuals practicing psychology in the State; authorizing the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists to promulgate rules and regulations pertaining to certain persons expressly excepted from the psychology license requirement; repealing altering certain duties
