(4) The activities and services of an individual licensed or certified as a psychologist in any state who recently has become a resident of this State and has an application for a license[, with or without examination, pending before the Board] APPROVED BY THE BOARD, PROVIDED THAT THE INDIVIDUAL PASSES THE FIRST SCHEDULED EXAMINATION FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT IS ELICIBLE.

IF FOR GOOD CAUSE THE INDIVIDUAL IS UNABLE TO TAKE THE FIRST SCHEDULED EXAMINATION FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE, THE BOARD MAY GRANT AN EXTENSION TO THE INDIVIDUAL TO TAKE THE NEXT SCHEDULED EXAMINATION FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE.
