Mental Health - Residential Placements of Individuals with Mental Disorders

FOR the purpose of requiring the Director of the Mental Hygiene Administration in the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to prepare a master plan to be updated annually by a certain date, for residential placements and support services for individuals who have a mental disorder, defining a certain term; providing that, as funds are provided by the Governor in the Budget, the Director of the Mental Hygiene Administration shall implement the plan in a manner which insures orderly transition of individuals.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(A) IN THIS SECTION "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.
