

(C) THE PREMIUMS AND FEES NEED NOT BE UNIFORM AMONG TRANSACTIONS, AND MAY VARY IN AMOUNT:

(1) AMONG TRANSACTIONS; AND

(2) AT DIFFERENT STAGES DURING THE TERMS OF TRANSACTIONS.

(D) A DETERMINATION BY THE AUTHORITY SHALL REMAIN EFFECTIVE THROUGHOUT THE PERIOD DURING WHICH THE BONDING ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE AUTHORITY IS IN EFFECT.

(A) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY MAKE OR CAUSE ANY FALSE STATEMENT OR REPORT TO BE MADE IN ANY APPLICATION OR IN ANY DOCUMENT FURNISHED TO THE AUTHORITY.

(B) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY MAKE OR CAUSE ANY FALSE STATEMENT OR REPORT TO BE MADE FOR THE PURPOSE OF INFLUENCING THE ACTION OF THE AUTHORITY ON AN APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE OR FOR THE PURPOSE OF INFLUENCING ANY ACTION OF THE AUTHORITY AFFECTING BONDING ASSISTANCE WHETHER OR NOT SUCH ASSISTANCE MAY HAVE ALREADY BEEN EXTENDED.

(C) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS, OR BOTH.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

(House Bill 595)

AN ACT concerning
