EFFECTIVE AFTER ADOPTION BY A CONSTITUTIONAL MAJORITY OF EACH HOUSE VOTING SEPARATELY.

- BASIS AND SHALL SUPPLEMENT, BUT MAY NOT BE IN CONFLICT WITH, THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 40A OF THE CODE.
- (C) THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES MAY REFER TO THE COMMITTEE ANY MATTER THAT THEY CONSIDER APPROPRIATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

2-701.

In this subtitle, "Committee" means the Joint Committee on Legislative Ethics.

2-702.

There is a Joint Committee on Legislative Ethics, which is a joint committee of the Senate and the House. 2-703.

- (a) (1) The Committee consists of the following 12 members:
 - (1) from the Senate:
 - (i) 1. the President EX OFFICIO; and
- $(\pm\pm)$ 2. 5 other Senators-,- appointed by the President; and
 - (2) (II) from the House:
 - (i) 1. the Speaker EX OFFICIO; and
- $(\pm\pm)$ 2. 5 other Delegates-7- appointed by the Speaker.
- (3) (2) AT LEAST 1 MEMBER FROM THE SENATE AND 1 MEMBER FROM THE HOUSE SHALL BE FROM THE PARTY OF THE MINORITY LEADER.
- (b) (1) A member appointed by the President serves at the pleasure of the President.
- . (2) A member appointed by the Speaker serves at the pleasure of the Speaker.
