FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Maryland Department of Transportation from spending any further funds for the construction of any new highway, arterial, freeway, or expressway in a certain right-of-way reserved for the project designated as the Rockville Facility in Montgomery County; providing an exception for certain improvements constructed at certain grade intersections and railroad crossings; and generally relating to the spending of certain funds in a certain right-of-way reserved for a project designated as the Rockville Facility in Montgomery County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Transportation Section 8-601 Annotated Code of Maryland (1977 Volume and 1983 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

8-601.

- (a) The Administration shall construct, reconstruct, and repair State highways as necessary and shall maintain them in good condition.
- (b) The Department may not spend any further funds for the construction of[:
- (1)] I-95 through Prince George's County that will involve a new or reconstructed segment connecting it to any other highway in Prince George's County. THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT SPEND ANY FURTHER FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HIGHWAY, ARTERIAL, FREEWAY, OR EXPRESSWAY IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY DESCRIBED IN THE 1980 HIGHWAY NEEDS INVENTORY AS THE RIGHT-OF-WAY RESERVED FOR THE PROJECT DESIGNATED AS THE ROCKVILLE FACILITY IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY.
- (C) THIS PROHIBITION DOES NOT PRECLUDE THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AT GRADE INTERSECTIONS AND RAILROAD CROSSINGS IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY DESIGNATED AS THE ROCKVILLE FACILITY TO FACILITATE TRAFFIC FLOW AND HIGHWAY SAFETY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
