(House Bill 915)

AN ACT concerning

Law Enforcement Officers - Regulation of Secondary Employment

~~FOR the purpose of permitting a law enforcement agency to regulate law enforcement officer's secondary employment for certain purposes.~~

FOR the purpose of providing that a law enforcement agency may not prohibit secondary employment of law enforcement officers; and providing that a law enforcement agency may promulgate certain regulations with regard to such employment.

BY adding to

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments
Section 729A
Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

729A.

A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY NOT PROHIBIT SECONDARY EMPLOYMENT BUT MAY PROMULGATE REASONABLE REGULATIONS AS TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S SECONDARY EMPLOYMENT AS NECESSARY TO PROHIBIT A CONFLICT OF INTEREST IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE OFFICER'S OFFICIAL DUTIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
