for borrowing money and shall be regarded as supplemental and additional to powers conferred upon the County by other laws and shall not be regarded as in derogation of any power now existing; and all Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland heretofore passed authorizing the County to borrow money are hereby continued to the extent that the powers contained in such Acts have not heretofore been exercised, and nothing herein contained shall be construed to impair, in any way whatsoever, the validity of any bonds which may have been issued by the County under the authority of any said Acts, and the validity of said bonds is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved. This Act, being necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of Cecil County, shall be liberally construed to effect the purposes All Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the hereof. provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 11. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 454

(House Bill 930)

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Sign Boards and Posts - Penalties

FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions of law relating to maliciously defacing, tearing down, or destroying sign boards or posts in Cecil County to include only county maintained signs or beards posts; altering penalties; and generally relating to sign boards and posts in Cecil County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

The Public Local Laws of Cecil County Section 18-6 Article 8 - Public Local Laws of Maryland (1970 Edition and December, 1982 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 8 - Cecil County
