

(1) -- DEFINE, -- FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, -- "QUALIFIED INDIVIDUAL", -- AND

(1) -- ADOPT -- RULES -- AND -- REGULATIONS -- TO -- GOVERN -- THE ISSUANCE, -- SUSPENSION, -- AND -- REVOCATION -- OF -- LICENSES -- FOR -- QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS, -- AND

(C) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO:

(1) GOVERN THE ISSUANCE, SUSPENSION, AND REVOCATION OF LICENSES FOR QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS WHO INSPECT RADIATION MACHINES;

(2) ESTABLISH INSPECTION PROCEDURES AND A SCHEDULE FOR THE PERIODIC INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION OF RADIATION MACHINES;

(3) ESTABLISH A FEE SCHEDULE THAT IS SUFFICIENT ONLY TO COVER THE COSTS OF CERTIFICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT; AND

(4) PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR THE FAILURE TO CERTIFY RADIATION MACHINES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 462

(House Bill 1070)

AN ACT concerning

Election Code - Continuing Committees

FOR the purpose of providing that certain political committees are required to file reports or statements of contributions and expenditures only once in any year during which the political committee does not make expenditures for electoral purposes; providing for the filing of an affidavit in lieu of scheduled reports under certain circumstances; providing for certain penalties under certain circumstances if certain contributions are received or expenditures are made after certain scheduled reporting dates; providing for the establishment of certain regulations by the State Administrator of Election Laws regarding the form of a certain affidavit; and generally relating to certain reports
