

(B) CHEMICAL INFORMATION LISTS SHALL BE:

- (1) ARRANGED IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER ACCORDING TO COMMON NAME;
- (2) REVISED AND REALPHABETIZED BIENNIALY; AND
- (3) MAINTAINED FOR AT LEAST 40 YEARS.

(C) A HAZARDOUS CHEMICAL NOT ALREADY ON THE CHEMICAL INFORMATION LIST SHALL BE ADDED TO THE CHEMICAL INFORMATION LIST WITHIN 30 DAYS OF ITS INTRODUCTION INTO THE PLACE--OF--EMPLOYMENT WORKPLACE; HOWEVER, IT NEED NOT BE PLACED ON THE LIST IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER UNTIL THE NEXT BIENNIAL REVISION OF THE CHEMICAL LIST.

32F.

(A) AN EMPLOYER SHALL DEVELOP OR OBTAIN A MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET OR, IN THE CASE OF A CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE, A CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE MANIFEST FOR EACH HAZARDOUS CHEMICAL IDENTIFIED ON THE CHEMICAL INFORMATION LIST.

(B) (1) A MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET SHALL--

(1) INCLUDE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSIONER--AND.

(2) IF INFORMATION IS NOT FOUND FOR ANY LISTED CATEGORY ON THE MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET, THE EMPLOYER SHALL SO INDICATE ON THE SHEET.

32G.

(A) THE CHEMICAL MANUFACTURER, IMPORTER, OR DISTRIBUTOR SHALL ENSURE THAT EACH CONTAINER OF HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS LEAVING ITS WORK PLACE IS LABELED, TAGGED, OR MARKED WITH THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (1) IDENTITY OF THE HAZARDOUS CHEMICAL;
- (2) APPROPRIATE HAZARD WARNINGS; AND
- (3) NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE CHEMICAL MANUFACTURER, IMPORTER OR DISTRIBUTOR.

(B) CHEMICAL MANUFACTURERS, IMPORTERS, OR DISTRIBUTORS SHALL ENSURE THAT EACH CONTAINER OF HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS LEAVING ITS WORK PLACE IS LABELED, TAGGED, OR MARKED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION IN A MANNER WHICH DOES NOT CONFLICT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION ACT, AND REGULATIONS ISSUED UNDER THAT ACT BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
