- (y) (8) TO NUMBER OR RENUMBER HOUSES, BUSINESSES, OR -OTHER BUILDINGS OR OTHER PROPERTY WITHIN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY; TO NAME OR RENAME STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY; TO PUT UP SIGNS SHOWING THESE NUMBERS AND NAMES; TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CHANGING THESE NUMBERS AND NAMES; AND TO ADOPT A COUNTY PLAN FOR THIS NUMBERING AND NAMING THAT MAY INCLUDE OFFICIAL MAPS, DRAWINGS, OR OTHER NECESSARY DOCUMENTS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 468

(House Bill 1245)

AN ACT concerning

Housing Discrimination - Elderly

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a landlord, real estate agent, or real estate broker from refusing to rent or sell to a person at least 62 years of age or older under certain circumstances.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 49B - Human Relations Commission Section 20 Annotated Code of Maryland (1979 Replacement Volume and 1983 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 49B - Human Relations Commission

20.

- (A) It shall be an unlawful discriminatory housing practice, because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, marital status, or physical or mental handicap, for any person having the right to sell, rent, lease, control, construct, or manage any dwelling constructed or to be constructed, or any agent or employee of such person:
- (1) To refuse to sell or rent after the making of a bona fide offer, or to refuse to negotiate for the sale or rental of, or otherwise make unavailable or deny, a dwelling.
