- (ii) If the local educational agency declines to contract, the Department [of Health and Mental Hygiene] may operate an education program directly or contract with another qualified provider.
- (4) Until a separate program is established for each county, children from Charles, Calvert, and St. Mary's counties may be served by the Regional Institute in Prince George's County.
- (5) The Department [of Health and Mental Hygiene] shall establish guidelines in cooperation with the local board of education for the operation of the Regional Institute for Children and Adolescents in Prince George's County.

- REGULATIONS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THAT CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSION WHO RESIDE IN THE REGULAR CATCHMENT AREA SERVED BY THE INSTITUTION SHALL BE GRANTED PRIORITY IN ADMISSIONS TO THE INSTITUTION.
