- (iii) Partial care services, including day care services and night care services.
  - (iv) 24-hour emergency services.
  - (v) Aftercare services.
  - (vi) Consultation services.
  - (vii) Education services.
- (viii) Other preventive or rehabilitation
  services or treatment.
- (IX) COMMUNITY RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS.
- (2) Research and training that are designed to improve or extend these services are proper items of expense.

THE DIRECTOR SHALL:

- (1) SUPERVISE THE CARE AND RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF AND THE PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS THAT HAVE MENTAL ORDERS DISORDERS; AND
- (2) PROVIDE OR ENCOURAGE, BY CONSULTATION, COOPERATION, AND OR CONTRACT, ALL PROGRAMS NEEDED TO ENSURE THAT CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS ARE EVALUATED APPROPRIATELY AND PROVIDED COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL CARE.

THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT:

(1) ENSURE THAT A PRIVATE THERAPEUTIC GROUP HOME PROVIDES MENTAL HEALTH CARE AND TREATMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH PART IV OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
