IN PART ~~III~~ (IV) OF THIS SUBTITLE "PRIVATE THERAPEUTIC GROUP HOME" MEANS A SMALL PRIVATE GROUP HOME AS DEFINED IN § 10-514(E) OF THIS TITLE THAT ADMITS ~~CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS~~ PROVIDES RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE, AS WELL AS ACCESS TO A RANGE OF DIAGNOSTIC AND THERAPEUTIC MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, TO BE IDENTIFIED UNDER THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 10-924 OF THIS ARTICLE, FOR CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS WHO ARE IN NEED OF SUCH TREATMENTS.

THE DIRECTOR SHALL:

(1) SUPERVISE THE CARE AND RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF AND THE PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS THAT HAVE MENTAL ORDERS DISORDERS; AND

(2) PROVIDE OR ENCOURAGE, BY CONSULTATION, COOPERATION, AND OR CONTRACT, ALL PROGRAMS NEEDED TO ENSURE THAT CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS ARE EVALUATED APPROPRIATELY AND PROVIDED COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL CARE.

THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT:

(1) ENSURE THAT A PRIVATE THERAPEUTIC GROUP HOME PROVIDES MENTAL HEALTH CARE AND TREATMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH PART IV OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
