- (II) TO COORDINATE THE TREATMENT IN THE HOME WITH THE APPROPRIATE PUBLIC OR NONPUBLIC EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM CONDUCTED OUTSIDE OF THE HOME; AND
- (111) TO PROVIDE 24-HOUR SUPERVISION FOR EACH CHILD AND ADOLESCENT FOR THE TIME THAT THE CHILD AND ADOLESCENT ARE NOT PARTICIPATING IN A PROGRAM CONDUCTED OUTSIDE OF THE HOME. 10-923.
- (A) APPLICATION FOR PLACEMENT OF A CHILD OR ADOLESCENT IN A PRIVATE THERAPEUTIC GROUP HOME MAY BE MADE UNDER THIS SECTION BY THE-FOLLOWING-PERSONS:
 - (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS 16 YEARS OLD OR OLDER;
- (2)--ON--BEHALF--OF-A-CHILD-OR-ADOLESCENT;-A-PARENT-OR GUARDIAN-OF-THE-PERSON-OF-THE-CHILD-OR-ADOLESCENT;
- (2) A PARENT OR GUARDIAN ON BEHALF OF THE CHILD OR ADOLESCENT;
- (3) WITH THE CONSENT OF THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF-THE PERSON OF THE CHILD OR ADOLESCENT, A PSYCHIATRIST OR PSYCHOLOGIST WHO TREATS THE CHILD OR ADOLESCENT;
- (4) ON BEHALF OF A CHILD OR ADOLESCENT, A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES WHEN THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT HAS CUSTODY OR GUARDIANSHIP OF THE CHILD OR ADOLESCENT UNDER SECTION 3-820 OF THE COURTS AND JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS ARTICLE;
- (5) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OR THE LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY WITH THE CONSENT OF A PARENT OR GUARDIAN;
- (6) ON BEHALF OF A CHILD <u>OR ADOLESCENT</u>, THE JUVENILE SERVICES ADMINISTRATION WHEN THE ADMINISTRATION HAS CUSTODY OR GUARDIANSHIP OF -A- THE CHILD OR ADOLESCENT UNDER SECTION 3-820 OF THE COURTS AND JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS ARTICLE; OR
- (7) THE CIRCUIT COURT OF A COUNTY, BALTIMORE CITY SITTING AS THE JUVENILE COURT, AND IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THE DISTRICT COURT SITTING AS JUVENILE COURT.
